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Side Letter UC Berkeley – EECS and Data Science UGSI Fee Remission and Staffing <u>Part A</u>

The University of California, Berkeley ("UC Berkeley") and the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America, Local 2865 ("UAW" or "Union") agree to the following terms and conditions to apply to undergraduate employees in the specific departments and courses as specified in this agreement.

A. General Considerations

- a. This Side Letter is only applicable to undergraduate students appointed to Academic Student Employee (ASE) titles, <u>including any new titles created by</u> <u>this agreement</u>, hired in courses in the Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Sciences (EECS) and Data Science courses offered by Data Science Undergraduate Studies (DSUS).
- b. This agreement pertains only to the appointments named in this agreement and shall not be precedent setting on any other matter, waive, or modify any other provisions of the current collective bargaining agreement.
- c. <u>The provisions of this side letter shall apply to and modify the contents of</u> <u>Side Letter "UGSI Fee Remission and Staffing Part B" as agreed to by UC</u> <u>Berkeley and the UAW.</u>

B. Side Letter Joint Labor Management Meetings

- During the life of the agreement, the parties agree to meet at least one time <u>per</u> <u>term</u> per academic year to review the implementation and effectiveness of the Side Letter.
- b. The meeting shall include representatives from UC Berkeley, the Union, and undergraduate academic student employees for EECS and Data Science courses.
- c. The parties shall mutually develop the agenda of the meeting.

C. Overwork Mitigation

a. <u>All appointment letters, job postings, and application forms in EECS and</u> <u>Data Science shall include the following disclaimer: "Working beyond the</u> <u>hours for which you are appointed or regularly taking on job duties outside</u> <u>of your job title will not confer any advantage in hiring, re-hiring, or</u> <u>promotion. If you believe you are working beyond your hours or are being</u> <u>asked to complete job duties outside of your job title, you can contact your</u> <u>union representatives at berkeley@uaw2865.org."</u> UAW Non-Binding Supposal UGSI Fee Remission and Staffing Part A UAW 2865 – UC Berkeley EECS and Data Science Bargaining – March 3rd, 2023 Page 2 of 2

D. Diversity in Hiring

- a. <u>The University and the Union mutually agree that improving the</u> <u>representation of underrepresented minorities among hired bargaining unit</u> <u>members in EECS and Data Science is a priority.</u>
- b. <u>Both parties shall monitor progress towards this goal during the duration of</u> <u>the agreement. Evaluation and discussion of progress towards this goal shall</u> <u>be discussed at Side Letter Joint Labor Management Meetings.</u>

E. EECS and Data Science Employee Orientations

- a. Within one month of the beginning of each academic <u>term year semester</u>, the Department and Union shall schedule a mandatory orientation meeting for <u>each</u> <u>course staff with greater than 5 bargaining unit members in EECS and Data</u> <u>Science bargaining unit members in EECS and Data Science</u>. <u>These orientations</u> <u>should be scheduled in conjunction with and as an integral part of a course</u> <u>staff meeting for each course, preferably during the first such meeting held.</u>
- b. <u>After one month but within two months of the beginning of each academic</u> <u>semester, the Department and the Union shall schedule a department-wide</u> <u>mandatory orientation for workers who did not attend a previous EECS and</u> <u>Data Science Employee Orientation in that semester.</u>
- c. <u>EECS and Data Science Employee Orientations shall operate as per Section</u> <u>E, "Access for Purposes of UAW Orientation" of Article 28, Union Access</u> <u>and Rights, of the UAW 2865 Collective Bargaining Agreement unless</u> <u>otherwise modified by this agreement.</u> The Union and the Department shall <u>mutually agree to the agenda.</u>

F. Departmental Faculty Orientations

- a. Within one month of the beginning of each academic year, the Department and Union shall schedule an orientation meeting for faculty <u>and instructors of</u> <u>record</u> in EECS and Data Science. <u>The Department shall be responsible for</u> <u>encouraging faculty and instructors of record to attend the orientation.</u>
- b. The Union and the Department shall mutually agree to the agenda.
